Health Insurance When You're Pregnant

Are you pregnant and need health insurance?

BadgerCare Plus is state of Wisconsin Medicaid. It pays for the baby's delivery and your health care while you're pregnant. For the mom, this health insurance lasts 60 days after the baby is born.

What if I already have health insurance?

You may still qualify. It depends on your household income.



BadgerCare Plus when you're pregnant:

You may qualify for BadgerCare Plus if:

- You are pregnant
- Your household's monthly income is equal or lower than:

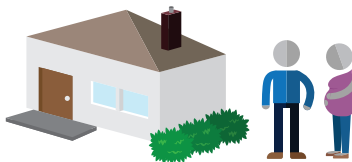
Income before taxes

Count each unborn baby in family size

Example of mom qualifying:

Household size: 3
 Family: 2 married adults, and 1 baby on the way
 Income: \$5,539 or less a month



Are you an immigrant?

Lawfully present immigrants:

You can get BadgerCare Plus if you are pregnant.

Undocumented immigrants:

You may qualify for BadgerCare Plus Prenatal Services.

Your information will not be shared with Immigration.

After your baby is born:

BadgerCare Plus:

Get **BadgerCare Plus** for your baby and then see if other family members qualify.

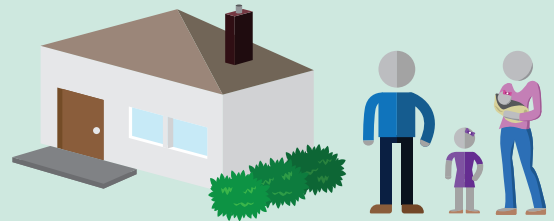
1. Call 1-800-362-3002 and ask for your county agency phone number.
Tell the county agency the baby was born.
2. Say you need BadgerCare Plus for the newborn and any other children in your household.
3. Ask if the adults in your household will qualify.

Example of everyone qualifying:

Household size: 4

Family: 2 married adults, 2 children

Income: \$2,000/month



Healthcare.gov:

Healthcare.gov is the federal Health Insurance Marketplace:

If anyone in your family does not qualify for BadgerCare Plus, they might qualify for financial help from the Marketplace.

Sign up within 60 days of the baby's birth or during Open Enrollment: November 1st - January 15th.

Get help from a local agency: Call the **2-1-1 helpline**. Ask for local help near you

If you can't get insurance:

Go to a free clinic or community health center

To find a clinic near you, call 2-1-1. Free clinics help people for free. Community Health Centers have financial help to lower the bill.
